For those saying *kaddish* during the eleven months of mourning this is a tremendous support mechanism. We at K.I. are working hard to provide our members with great programming, an education for those with children of school age, continuing adult education, Rabbi Shron's *Shabbat* afternoon class before *Mincha, Maariv and Havdallah* or conclusion of *Shabbat*, which is a very moving service. Our *Chanukah* party was very well received, Grand Givers, our main fundraiser featured Capitol Steps, who were extremely entertaining and we are in the process of rolling out a women's program, *Purim* Ball and another of our Caviar Family Scholar-in-Residence Series in the future.
