From Your Rabbi...



Shanah Tova to all! As I write this, we are in the midst of the Ten Days of Repentance; coming out of Rosh Hashanah and on our way to Yom Kippur. Rosh Hashanah services were beautiful here at K.I. I was so happy to finally get to meet Rabbi Shron in

person and to see him and the choir in action. I told him that he really lived up to the hype! The davening was truly uplifting. It was inspiring to see how the sanctuary opens up into the hallway, making the shul atmosphere feel more majestic for the High Holidays. Looking out from my perch on the bimah and seeing a packed house gave me much *nachas* - especially because I now recognize so many of the faces that I was looking at! As I mentioned before my sermon on the first day, we also had a nice little historical tidbit to celebrate this past Rosh Hashanah – no less than four K.I. rabbis participated in leading the services. We had Rabbi Shron, of course, who served as the chazzan; we had me, as your stalwart new rabbi, officiating the services. Our rabbi emeritus. Rabbi Mandl, blew *shofar* on the first day. And finally, the Torah reading on the first day was lained by Rabbi Seymour Krinsky, who once served as both assistant rabbi of K.I. as well as an acting interim rabbi - long before I was born!

As you read this, the long holiday season will be winding down. As we prepare to head back into the seemingly more boring, "regular" rhythm of the year, let us remember that while *Yom Kippur* is the holiest of all holidays, the rabbis teach us that every week's *Shabbat* is actually even holier still than Yom Kippur. This is reflected in the breakdown of the number of aliyot for the Torah reading for various different kinds of days. On regular weekly Mondays and Thursdays, we read three aliyot. On Rosh Chodesh we read four. On a regular Yom Tov, there are five *aliyot*. Yom Kippur's special status amongst the holidays is reflected in the fact that it gets one extra aliyah, over and above a regular Yom Tov – on Yom Kippur

I was going to add this article to my Yom Kippur speech, but Rosemary told me not to talk to long. So, I'm making this my president's message for the October Focal Point.

I came across this article that was written by Pastor Bob Morehead.

Being in the season of repentance and forgiveness, I thought this would be appropriate to share.

Some of you may have heard parts of this article, but I feel that this letter bears repeating.

The paradox of our time in history is that we have taller buildings but shorter tempers, wider freeways, but narrower viewpoints. We spend more, but have less, we buy more, but enjoy less. We have bigger houses and smaller families, more conveniences, but less time. We have more degrees but less sense, more knowledge, but less judgment, more experts, yet more problems, more medicine, but less wellness.

We drink too much, smoke too much, spend too recklessly, laugh too little, drive too fast, get too angry, stay up too late, get up too tired, read too little, watch TV too much, and pray too seldom.

We have multiplied our possessions, but reduced our values. We talk too much, love too seldom, and hate too often.

We've learned how to make a living, but not a life. We've added years to life not life to years. We've been all the way to the moon and back, but have trouble crossing the street to meet a new neighbor. We conquered outer space but not inner space. We've done larger things, but not better things.




