From the Rabbi...



Israelis have taken to referring to the October 7th massacre as "Shabbat HaShachor," or the black/dark Shabbat. I was thinking of this as I was studying the "Book of Esther," with the Purim fast approaching, when I came to the verse (Esther 8:16) "And the Jews had light and joy, and gladness and honor;" as well as the verse (Esther 9:1) "And in the twelfth month-which is the month of Adar-on the thirteenth day thereof, when the king's order and his edict drew near to be put into execution, on the day that the Jews' enemies looked forward to ruling over them, it was reversed, that the Jews should rule over their enemies."

That sense of "it was reversed" - in Hebrew, V'Nahafoch Hu, is an essential theme of Purim. The notion that things can be dark and scary until, suddenly and miraculously, circumstances reverse to a position of light and joy, leads us to see the hidden hand of G-d. The name of G-d is famously not mentioned in the Megillah, but we can

see His hand clearly operating behind the scenes.

This is the reality that we live in today. The strength and resilience of Israeli society in the months since the massacre are nothing short of inspirational. Whenever my cousins send me a video clip of a family *simcha* in Israel - a *bar mitzvah*, a wedding, a *bris* - I tell them that nothing gives me more joy these days than seeing such happy occasions in Israel. It shows our enemies that our national life in our land will go on. *V'Nahafoch Hu!* Their evil designs have been reversed.

That is the theme of *Purim*. Fittingly, our enemies today are also funded from Persia (Iran), just as in the "Book of Esther." Our hearts remain with the remaining hostages and their families, and it is my sincere hope that by the time you are reading this, they will all be freed. May we all have a joyous *Purim*.

Here comes March, soon. "In like a lion, out like a lamb," meaning, the weather starts the month bad (roaring like a lion), and leaves, in a much calmer and nicer way (gentle like a lamb). This started as a reference to astronomy, referring to the position of the constellations Leo (lion) and Aries (a ram or a baby lamb) in the night skies in the northern hemisphere.

We recently had *Tu B'Shvat*, which occurred on the 15th of *Shevat*, January 25. In contemporary Israel, this is the ecological awareness day, and trees are planted in celebration. This is also called the New Year for the Trees and the beginning of the agriculture cycle for the purpose of biblical tithes. On that evening, it is traditional to eat of the main seven species, five fruits and two grains (i.e., grapes, figs, pomegranates, olives, and dates; and two

grains, roasted wheat and barley).

In current events at K.I., I should mention the "Kitchen Shower." This so-called shower is being held to replace the pots, plans and gadgets that have been utilized for many years, to be exact 38 years, and need to be replaced. Please choose a gift from the K.I. Kitchen Shower registry online at kisyn.org or donate to the K.I. general fund with a note saying it is for the Kitchen Shower. Everyone who contributes either way will be invited to a Kitchen Shower in March.

At this point, I would like to convey a *Mazel Tov* to **Cantor Hayoun** and his extended family on the birth of a great-grandchild in late January and of a grandchild in early February in Israel.

On a different note, I would like to encourage or even ask our members to come to our morning or evening daily services as we need more people to attend to make a *minyan*. Just pick at least one day a week and help us make a quorum (*minyan*).

Please save the date Sunday, March 24 for our *Purim* celebration that includes a play "Persian Version of Grease," followed by an authentic multicourse Persian cuisine. For those of you who have not attended one of these events, I encourage you to come and enjoy as it's lots of fun.

Our annual congregational meeting will take place on **Sunday**, **April 7**, **at 10:00 am**, followed by a delicious brunch. This is where we as members of K.I. will practice our democratic rights and vote for our favorite candidates.

Finally, please notice the flagpole picture on page 10 that was recently taken of the flagpoles directly in front of the main entrance of K.I. Notice the eagle sitting on the Israeli flagpole. To me it demonstrates the Israel military might and constitutional strength. *Am Israel Chai*.

This is one of our minor fast days, meaning it is observed from break of day until evening and not a 24 hour fast like *Yom Kippur*. In the *Megillah* of Esther, the Jewish people are commanded to fast in memory of the events of the *Purim* festival and the Jews being saved in the land of Persia.

The fast begins at 6:00 am and will conclude at 8:02 pm. But one should preferably not eat until after hearing the *Megillah*.


