ISRAEL UPDATE - January 26, 2024

Bipartisan Letter Condemns South Africa's False Accusations Against Israel at the ICJ

A bipartisan group of 210 House lawmakers sent a letter on Tuesday condemning South Africa's genocide case against Israel at the International Court of Justice (ICJ) as "grossly unfounded and defamatory." The letter, led by Reps. Chris Smith (R-NJ) and Kathy Manning (D-NC) and addressed to Secretary of State Antony Blinken, expresses the lawmakers' "disgust at this filing, which perpetrates false and dangerous allegations against the Jewish state." The letter states, "We share the administration's position that Israel has the right to defend itself against Hamas terror... South Africa's accusation of genocide against Israel exposes how far Israel's enemies will go in their attempts to demonize the Jewish state. While barely acknowledging the Hamas terrorists who gleefully massacred, mutilated, raped, and kidnapped innocent civilians on October 7, South Africa makes grossly unfounded and defamatory charges against Israel on the world stage." The letter calls on the administration to continue standing with Israel against South Africa's false and outrageous accusations and oppose South Africa's case at the ICJ. It's vital that America's leaders continue to publicly stand with Israel, speak out forcefully against South Africa's defamatory accusations, and push back against efforts to isolate and delegitimize Israel on the world stage.
