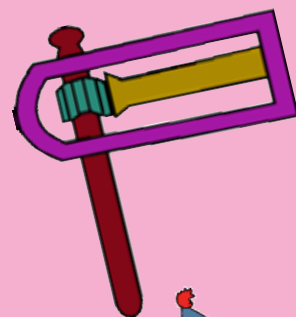

ISRAEL UPDATE -- February 1, 2019

Intel to Invest \$11b in Israel and Add Thousands of Jobs, Finance Chief Says

Tech giant Intel is expected to invest some 40 billion shekels (\$11 billion) to build a new manufacturing facility in Israel, Finance Minister Moshe Kahlon announced on Monday. According to *Haaretz*, the Israeli government is expected to provide the corporation with a grant of some 3.2 billion shekels, about 8 percent of what will be the largest single investment ever made in Israel. Intel is expected to build the new plant alongside its present semiconductor manufacturing facility in Kiryat Gat, on a 75 acre plot just south of the existing plant. Intel has committed to adding another 1,000 to 2,000 new jobs at the new plant, which is scheduled to be completed within five years. Currently, Intel Israel employs about 11,000 workers in manufacturing and research and development. [...] Kahlon said the government has been working with Intel for a year on the project and Intel management informed him of the "unprecedented" decision on Monday "that is expected to bring thousands of jobs to the south."
