

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED TO MAKE PASSOVER MEAL DELIVERIES

Passover is not far away, and JFs and the Rabbinical Association of KC have teamed up for the annual food drive making sure those who are hungry will have all the makings to enjoy for a traditional seder.

Area congregations are collecting various Passover food items such as boxes of matzah ball soup mix, matzah baking mixes, matzah meal, potato starch. These items may also be dropped off during business hours in designated barrels in lobby of The J or JFS' Brookside location Please donate items by March 31. You can also shop for these items through the JFS Pantry Wish List on Amazon (<https://amzn.to/3XH5v7Z>), your preferred online retailer or make a financial contribution to the pantry at jfskc.org/donate. This year, JFS will provide prepared Kosher-for-Passover meals to 240 client households (about 400 people) for the Festival of Freedom, which begins at sundown, Monday, April 22. Kosher Caterer Kim Matsil is preparing delicious, traditional meals that will include a main dish and dessert. In addition, each household will also receive fresh produce, matzah and matzah ball soup to celebrate the holiday. ISRAEL UPDATE - March 15, 2024

**Israeli-American Taken Hostage On Oct. 7
Confirmed Dead**

Israel announced on Tuesday that 19-year-old Itay Chen — a U.S. citizen who was taken hostage by Hamas — was killed on October 7 when Hamas terrorists crossed into Israel and attacked his base, and that his body is being held in Gaza. Itay, also an Israeli citizen, served as a soldier in the IDF and was stationed at the Nahal Oz base on the border with Gaza. Itay was one of six Americans still considered alive and held hostage in Gaza. His parents — Rubi and Hagit Chen — were leading the campaign for the release of American hostages held by Hamas and attended the State of the Union last week with other hostage families. "Our hearts are broken. We loved him so much, and we would have done anything to bring him home alive," Chen's parents said in a statement. President Biden said, "I reaffirm my pledge to all the families of those still held hostage: we are with you. We will never stop working to bring your loved ones home." AIPAC joins the Chen family and the people of Israel in grieving, and we redouble our commitment to fighting for the release of all 134 hostages.
