## From the President...



When you read this month's *Focal Point* article I will have presided over my first officers' meeting and Board of Directors meeting as congregational president. One project we hope to complete very soon is our K.I. Bylaws update project. We will be providing a redlined copy to the congrega-

tion which outlines the changes requested compared to the current language. I will also be providing a brief overview of the changes being requested and what the changes mean as compared to the current bylaws language. By providing this overview it is my sincere hope that my explanation will dispel any appearance of impropriety, by just trying to pass the bylaws changes requested without a proper explanation of what the changes mean to the document and therefore the congregation. It is my hope that we can conclude this process in the near future.

We are currently seeking three competitive bids for what I'm calling an audit but in reality will actually be a review. My understanding is that there are three basic types of audits, ranging from an indepth forensic audit, to what is known as a compilation. What we are looking for is a review which fits squarely in-between these other two. A review is done to get some assurance that our financial statements do not have known errors or departures from generally accepted accounting principles. It requires the CPA performing the review to be independent of our shul, perform inquiry and analytical procedures, and, if necessary, additional procedures as required if information obtained is questionable in any way. The accountant's report will then state that said report has been performed in accordance with AICPA professional standards and that nothing was found requiring material modifications for our statements to be in conformity with GAAP. To make this more understandable to the rest of us, it means they didn't find any significant errors or omissions in our documentation and that we are following the proper rules, procedures and

## From the Rabbi's Study...



Over the past two months I have shared with you my thoughts about what the role of a rabbi should be and what makes a thriving congregation. This month I would like to share with you some thoughts on what defines a *shul*/synagogue.

The synagogue should be the center of Jewish congregational life. It's where we go to pray as a congregation, to connect with our Creator, to connect with one another, to learn about and discuss Jewish topics, current events and anything and everything else we want to discuss amongst each other. It's where we go to teach our children about Judaism, to celebrate our joyous Jewish holidays and share meals together and maybe even find that special someone to share our life together.

Over the years, I have heard all the negative experiences that people have experienced in their *shuls* when growing up; an insensitive rabbi, a tyrannical Hebrew teacher, a stuffy and formal service, the list goes on and on. Forget the past. Then was then and now is now. It's a new day and a new way of operating. Times are different now and so are you. There are so many good things happening, great programs on the horizon, and so many new and good people becoming involved in all aspects of our *shul*.

As the rabbi of K.I., I encourage you to GET REAC-QUAINTED WITH THE SYNAGOGUE. Once you take that first step and begin attending *Shabbat* services, you may actually find it habit-forming and start to look forward to *Shabbat* mornings, sitting with and seeing the same people, catching up with them, hearing the *Torah Parasha* (portion) discussed each week, sharing in the happy occasions and enjoying a delicious *kiddush* and *schmoozing*. There's a lot that happens in *shul* on *Shabbat* morning and it just might surprise you how good and interesting and joyful it is.

Of course there are many different reasons to go to *shul*. You can go for the socialization if you wish; that's a perfectly good reason to go. Many people find it's an effective antidepressant to put on some decent clothes and go hear some great stories (from the *Torah*) and uplifting ideas, usually a pretty thoughtful sermon, some beautiful and spiritual prayers and songs, and then the *kiddush* - "refreshments!" It's really quite nice and something that I really look forward to.

Judaism is so RICH with good stuff - important ideas and ideals - challenging concepts - DEPTH - a group of bright




